General Information

- The Kishwaukee College Foundation Scholarships listed in this handbook are applied to tuition, fees, and books only. No monetary awards for these scholarships will be issued.
- Each scholarship has its unique and specific requirements and awards are made through a selection process that may consist of Deans, Department Heads, Faculty, and Donors that is overseen by the Kishwaukee College Foundation.
- The dollar amounts shown may be for multiple scholarships and are budgeted amounts that may be awarded for the fall semester. Students may re-apply for any remaining funds for the spring and summer semester. No new dollars will be budgeted for the spring & summer semesters.
- All awards are contingent upon acceptance for enrollment and compliance with the scholarship process.
- Students are strongly encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) forms that are available in the college's Financial Aid Office – even if it is not a specific requirement of the scholarships they are applying for. - Scholarships are listed primarily by academic division and in some cases, by other attributes including geographic region or other criteria set by the donor.
- Unless otherwise noted, all applications must be electronically sent to the Kishwaukee College Foundation Office completed and with all supportive documentation no later than:

Fall Semester: APRIL 30TH, 2008

Spring & Summer Semester: NOVEMBER 1ST, 2008

In fairness to all students, applications received after this date may not be eligible for consideration.

- Students who are selected for awards will be mailed notification on:
Fall Semester: June 13th, 2008
Spring & Summer Semester December 19th, 2008
- Scholarships that can be awarded to multiple Areas of Study are marked by a corresponding number ③ (i.e. History, Economics or Social Studies = ③)
- Enrollment in 12 hours or more at Kishwaukee College is considered **Full Time**.

How to apply for scholarships

- 1) **Foundation Web Site**
www.kishfoundation.com / scholarships / application. All applications must be submitted via the web site. If you need assistance in completing your application, you may speak to the Kishwaukee College Foundation Office. Room A232 or 815-825-2086 extension 266.
- 2) **Complete your application.**
You may apply for multiple scholarships via one application. Be sure that all support documents for each chosen scholarship are attached to your application before clicking the “Send” button. Clicking on the “Review Requirements” icon will produce a small window containing all requirements for each scholarship.
- 3) **Complete additional requirements.**
In many instances, scholarships require that you submit additional support documents, letters or essays. All support documents should be attached to the application as MS Word or compatible documents or scanned in and attached as PDF’s. ALL letters of reference and/or statements of fact must include the contact information of the author.

EXCEPTION: When required, all Federal Student Financial Aid Forms (FAFSA) should be completed and turned into the Financial Aid Office. The corresponding box located in the Financial Information Section should then be checked. FAFSA applications can be obtained through the Financial Aid Office (815-8258-2086 ext. 224) or by going to;
